






Gender-based Analysis Plus



Gender-based Analysis Plus is an intersectional analytical process we undertake to identify who is impacted by an issue we are trying to address through our initiative. It involves examining intersecting identity factors, and considering social, economic, and cultural conditions and norms.



In applying **GBA Plus**, many factors need to be considered. The needs and experiences of different groups of people are influenced by intersecting parts of their identity, the context they are in and their lived experiences.





The Gender, Diversity and Inclusion Statistics Hub

The Gender, Diversity and Inclusion Statistics (GDIS) Hub, first launched in 2018 and was updated on December 8th 2021.

The Sex, Gender and Sexual Orientation Hub was developed to

- monitor and report on indicators included in the Gender Results Framework
- provide data and analyses on gender and LGBTQ2+ communities.





Gender Results Framework

In Budget 2018, the Government of Canada introduced **The Gender Results Framework (GRF)** which identifies priority areas of action for advancing gender equality.

The **GRF** is designed to

- track how Canada is currently performing
- define what is needed to achieve greater equality
- determine how progress will be measured going forward.

The Disaggregated Data Action Plan


(DDAP) will lead to detailed statistical information to highlight the experiences of specific population groups, such as women, Indigenous peoples, racialized populations and people living with disabilities.




