- Ordering soon or in process: Credit Report Characteristics (TransUnion), Canadian Business Patterns (Industry Canada), Building Permits (StatCan), General Social Survey (StatCan), Labour Force Survey (StatCan)
- Waiting on legal feud to resolve before acquiring Taxfiler data (should we go directly to CRA?)
- Schedule B needs to be updated

- From GSS, measures of voluntarism and daily time usage (if question still exists) at CSD level would be of valuable
