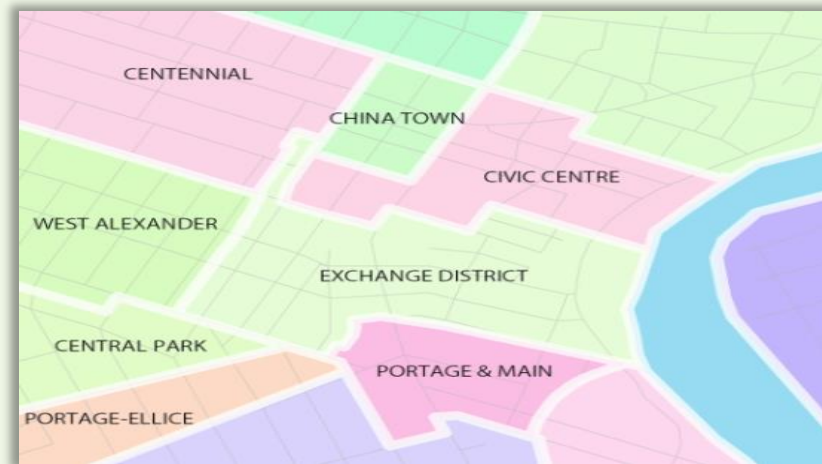

1. WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY DATA PROGRAM?

Origins of the program

- Established in the 1990s
- Data cost sharing strategy
- From Statistics Canada primarily
- Analyze and report on socioeconomic trends
- Focus on small area geography



The CDP Today

- Today, CDP provides access to a wealth of unique data products and serves the needs of hundreds of organizations
- Members organizations are part of a **consortium** - a legal entity focused on the implementation of a public service goal
- Local community data **consortia** participate in the national network, providing leadership and oversight
- the **consortium** model has evolved into a tool for community development

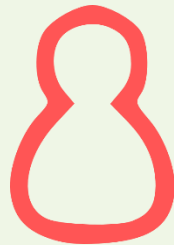


3. WHAT DATASETS ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE PROGRAM?

Broadly speaking...

- Smallest possible geographic scale
 - Always sub-provincial
 - Lower- and upper-tier municipalities
 - Neighbourhood-level where possible (DA, CT)
- Custom Statistics Canada data
 - Custom cross-tabulations
 - Custom boundaries
- Analysis, reporting, visualization tools
- Links to open data

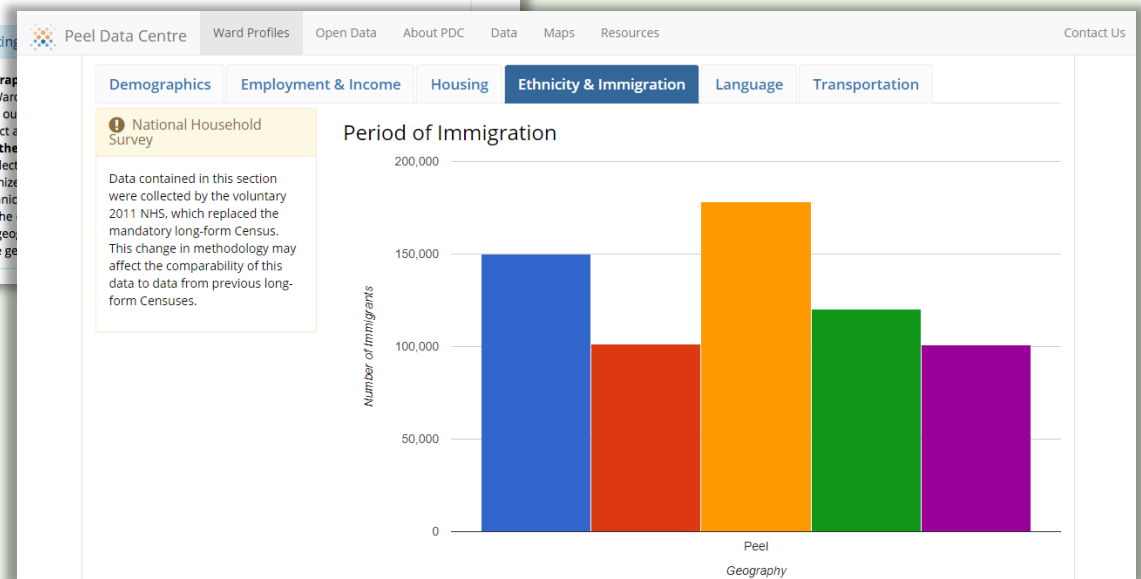

BIRTHPLACE OF OTTAWA'S IMMIGRANTS

As of 2011, the population of Ottawa included over 204,000 immigrants. By individual country of origin, the United Kingdom remains the birthplace of the largest proportion of Ottawa's immigrants. But taking a regional perspective, 43% of Ottawa's immigrant population was born in Asia or the Middle East. Most of these immigrants are from China, followed by Lebanon and India. Europe is the birthplace of the next largest segment, at 28%. Though the city's immigrant population has grown significantly in the past decade, Ottawa is far from a top destination of choice for new immigrants to Canada.

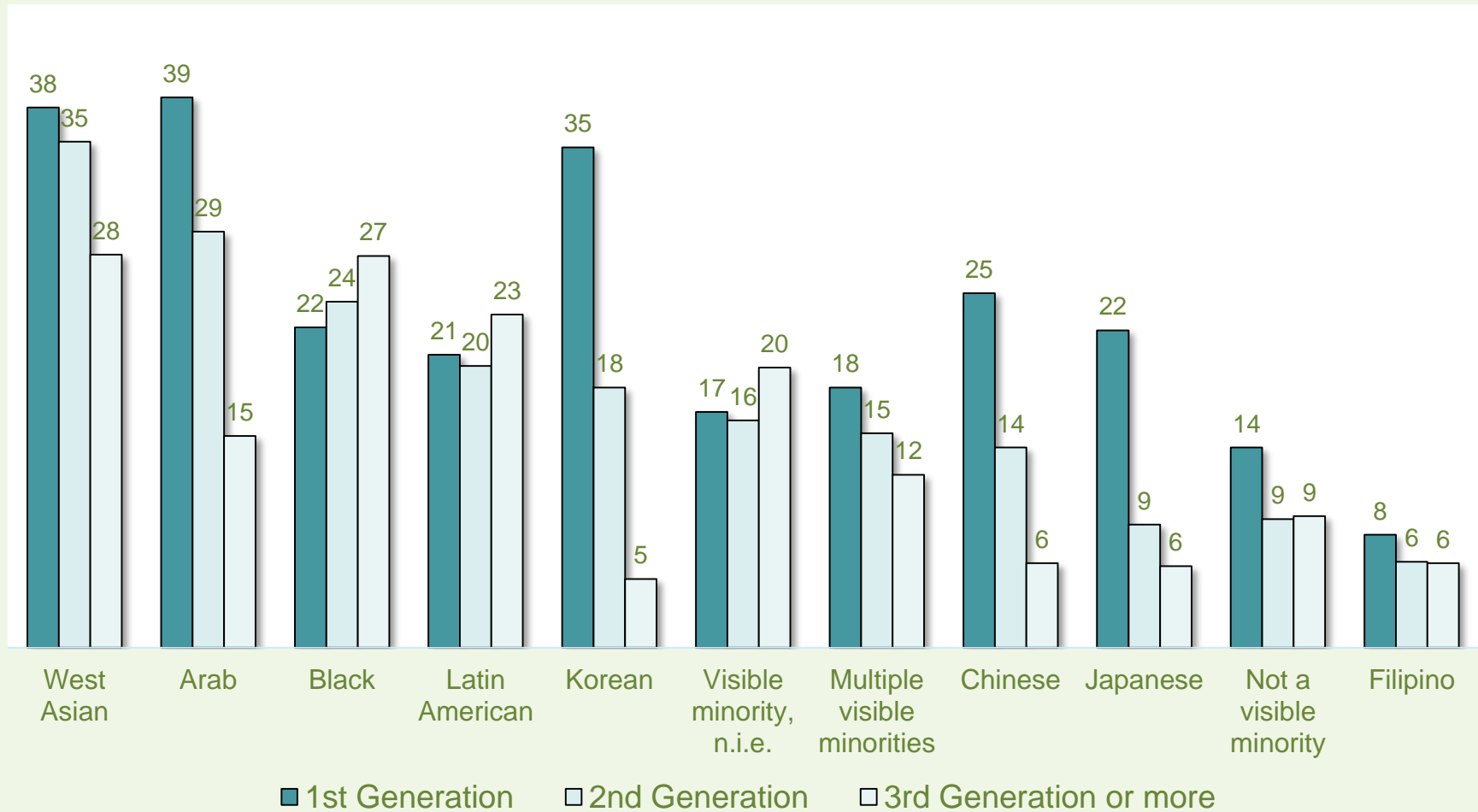
